North West Division is the host and Jerry “Flintlock” Haines has provided the following information to make your plans work best for you and your outpost FCF’ers.

All FCF members are urged to meet us on September 9/21-23/07 at the Southern Missouri District RR Campground in the FCF Village for a great time of fun and fellowship. The fee of \$10.00 covers meals (Fri supper, Sat breakfast lunch, supper, and Sun breakfast), and registration. It starts on Friday afternoon with setup and registration after 3 pm. The evening meal will be at 8 pm starting out a great weekend with a council fire service at 9 pm.

Right after Saturday breakfast we will stop for a morning devotion and then move right into all of the great competitions and events. Saturday’s events will be some old stand-bys; Hawk, Knife, Rifle, Outfit, and Flint/Steel. There will also be Archery (BYOPB is encouraged – that means if you have your own primitive bow feel free to bring it along), Horseshoes, Checkers, 2 special competitions; Seneca Run (with a rifle) and Dry Seneca (without rifle) and something new – Sash Pull. Somewhere in the day we will stop for a noon meal and end with supper.

Saturday morning also starts the Buckskin testing (see elsewhere in this publication for more info) and Saturday evening is the big Council Fire when we will have District Scout Elections, a Buckskin Ceremony, recognize new Wilderness Members, have some praise and worship then enjoy our special guest speaker, Jim “Two Crows” Wallen. Two Crows will share with us at all 3 devotions this weekend – so come prepared for a great time in the Lord.

Sunday morning right after breakfast we will take time for God with a service, then pack up and head for home.
