This year, we will be having a division-combined Frontier Adventure at the Stevens's Addition (Southern Missouri District Royal Ranger Campground) at Lake of the Ozarks. This is the same camp where we have our annual District Pow Wow.

This years Frontier Adventure will begin on the Friday evening of May 15th - 16th, 2008 and conclude late in the afternoon of Saturday.

The Frontier Adventure is a required event for you to become a member of the Frontiersman Camping Fellowship.

Please be in camp and set up no later than 7:30 p.m.

Your sponsor should also attend. Sponsors are to mentor their candidates and provide for their needs during this and future events.

Sometimes a sponsor cannot make the event. In that case, please coordinate with your chapter vice president for lodging.

In extreme cases, you might bring your own shelter. Modern shelters will be set up in a designated area outside of the Frontiersman Camping Fellowship village.

Each candidate will be assigned a company. The company will provide hard tack and jerky for the candidates which will serve as Saturday's breakfast and lunch. A feast for all will be served at the end of classes and testing.

Directions to POW WOW from Springfield, Missouri 100 mile

From Springfield Take I-44 North go to Lebanon Hwy 5 go Left at the Stop Light to Camdenton then take Hwy 54 through Osage Beach cross the Lake of the Ozark and keep on 54 and pass over the Osage River.

These directions take you from the Osage River just North of Osage Beach.

- 0.0 mi █ Depart US-54, Lake Ozark, MO 65049 on US-54 (North) for 2.1 mi
- 2.1 mi Turn LEFT (South-West) onto US-54 Bus for 0.2 mi
- 2.3 mi Turn RIGHT (West) onto SR-W for 54 yds
- 2.3 mi Bear RIGHT (North-West) onto SR-W [Highway W] for 0.2 mi
- 2.5 mi Keep STRAIGHT onto SR-W for 7.1 mi
- 9.6 mi Turn RIGHT (North) onto SR-W [SR-Y] for 1.3 mi
- 10.9 mi Turn RIGHT (South) onto Local road(s) for 120 yds
- 11.0 mi Turn LEFT (East) onto Local road(s) for 109 yds
- 11.0 mi █ Arrive near Rocky Mount
