The Basic DTC and JTC Basic is a 9 session course that will teach both Rangers and Commanders how to use the Patrol System and to use the Patrol System to teach Rangers how leadership and the team player concept works.

What: Only \$8.00 per person.

Where:
A lock in at Forest Ave AOG just north of Chestnut Expressway on Forest Ave.

Why: This will enable you and your rangers to bring the strength of the boys in boy lead leadership teaching both to lead and follow. Each commander and ranger will bring back to their outpost a better understanding of how the patrol system works and will be given tools to help use this valuable tool called boy lead leadership. You can expect the boys in your outpost to grow in all points of the Royal Ranger Emblem.



This picture of this outpost came from a group down in the Westplains area. These Rangers understood what the patrol system meant and what the patrol guides job is. They placed 1st place in the SW Division Pow Wow and had a fantastic camp.

We have a Nine session program that was developed by the National Royal Ranger Office to aid us in teaching this system.

Each Ranger and Commander will receive a DTC/JTC patch and certificate and each church will bring home a patrol standard as well as many ranger made patrol flags.

We will teach the proper chain of command where one person can effectively lead and get projects done using the Patrol System.
